
TOWNSHIP RIGHT OF WAY

Property owners are responsible for keeping the township right-of-way free and clear of obstacles. No structures can be built in the right-of-way, and if you plant trees or bushes in the right-of-way, there is a possibility they could be destroyed if the Township must do work there.

DROPPING OFF LIMBS

If you would like to drop off tree limbs, please call the township office (717-834-5281) ahead to arrange drop off. We only accept tree limbs 2 inches or more in diameter. No vines, leaves, brush, bamboo, or other yard waste.

Free woodchips can be picked up by the township garage. Please call the office to let us know when you would like to pick up and if you will need help loading.

Residential Projects

ACCESSORY STRUCTURES: Garages, sheds, chicken coops, etc.

If you are building an accessory structure, you need a zoning permit. If the structure is over 1,000 square feet, you need a building permit as well.

If the structure is under 1,000 square feet, but will be attached to your home, you need a zoning permit and a building permit.





FENCES: If you would like to install a fence, you need a zoning permit. If the fence will be over 6 feet in height, you also need a building permit.

HOT TUBS: Hot tubs require a zoning permit and a building permit.

POOLS: Pools require a zoning permit. A pool that is 24 inches deep or more, requires a building permit.



Ordinance Highlight

ORDINANCE NO. 117, Section 4, A.

No driveway, drainage facility, or Structure within an existing or dedicated highway right-of-way of Penn Township shall be constructed or altered and no drainage facility of the Township shall be altered or connected onto without first obtaining a permit from the Township. A permit may not be required for general maintenance of an existing improvement.





Would you like to serve your community by volunteering? The following boards have vacancies that need filled.

Municipal Authority: The Municipal Authority makes important decisions about water and sewer services in the Township. Meetings are the first Wednesday of the month at 7pm.

Park and Recreation: The Park and Rec Board hosts events such as the Chicken BBQ, craft fairs, give-away days, senior lunches, and events for children. They maintain the park and the community garden. Meetings are the second Tuesday of the month at 7pm.

Do I Need a Permit?

A **Zoning Permit** is required when any new structure is put on a property, or the use of the property is changing. The Zoning Permit Application shows the **location** of the structure you want to build or place on your property. The reason for this is to make sure you're not placing it too close to the property line, township right of way, or other important features.

A **Building Permit** is required for the construction of new buildings, additions, and some repairs/alterations within the home. Some examples you may not know about are hot tubs, installing a swimming pool, or changing the size of your windows.

A **Driveway Permit** is required when you wish to place a new driveway on your property.

A **Paving Permit** is required when you go from a dirt or gravel driveway to a paved driveway, or if you are repaving your existing driveway. This is to ensure that the driveway ties into the road properly and the swale is maintained for stormwater functions. An inspection is needed before any construction starts.

A **Sign Permit** is required for all new signs, when one business leaves and another comes in, and when a business changes its name.

Remembering Susan Long



Hey Susan...

This was the start of my text messages to Susan Long, followed by "something is wrong with the process, need your advice."

Susan Long retired from Susquenita School District and went on to work for the Municipal Authority (sewer and water) and the Township Office for over 20 years. Susan followed the application manuals for the computer process for the sewer and water billing. Her attention to detail was exceptional and locating incorrect calculations was an enjoyable challenge to her.

I had retired and took a part time job with the Municipal Authority in October 2022. I knew nothing about sewer systems, zero. Susan was asked to teach me the billing system, payroll, and paying vendors. I had so many challenges. Susan and I would talk several times a week. Susan would come to the office to discuss more details of the job. Many times, I would text her late into the evening as I sat at the office desk. "Hey Susan." I would describe the latest debacle, and she would stop by the office the next day with a "fix-it-plan."

In one of her last text messages from December 2024, Susan gave me instructions on tax spreadsheets and end of year reports. We were going to find time to meet. This was the last time we talked. Susan passed away this January.

Susan was a natural teacher, and a great listener. Susan was the straight man of the sewer comedy team. Hard on advice, if you asked, she would deliver exactly what her stance was on the subject. She talked about her women's groups, her church, and the enjoyment of providing music for the church services. Many of us felt Susan's support on our own journeys. Our entire community was better because of Susan Long.

Penn Township certainly needs more Susans. Her void everyday says it all, I know.

RECYCLING

Sylvester's Recycling Bags:

You can now purchase Sylvester's Recycling Bags at the Penn Township office building for \$4.00/EACH. When you fill a bag, bring it back to the Penn Township building and place it in the dumpster out front. A portion of the profit will benefit Penn Township Park & Recreation.

Recycling Center:

Located near the entrance to Hawk Rock Trail. Second Saturday of each month.

8:00am - 10:00am.

You will be asked for identification as proof of residency when dropping off.

The following items can be placed together in a bag or box:

- Steel cans
- Aluminum (cat food, foil)
- Plastics (identified with #)
 - Paper (junk mail, ads, etc.)

The following items must be separated:

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Newspapers tied or in paper bags.
- Cardboard

All recyclables should be clean, and all containers should be crushed.

The following items will NOT be accepted: Glass, Books, Electronics, Batteries, Light Bulbs, Styrofoam, Other metal, Dirty items, Non-Recyclable Items.



Planning Commission News

The Penn Township Planning
Commission is proposing revisions to the
Township Subdivision and Land
Development Ordinance. The revisions will
address changes to General Provisions,
Definitions, General Procedures and Plan
Requirements, Design Standards,
Improvement and Construction
Requirements and Recreational Areas. The
proposed revisions will be recommended to
the township supervisors after reviewed by
the Perry County Planning Commission and a
public meeting to receive public comments.
Prior to adoption, the supervisors will hold a
hearing on the ordinance amendment.

The Planning Commission will be reviewing updates to the Township Zoning Map. While the Planning Commission is considering changes, a letter sent to residents opened the opportunity to submit their own request for changes. Any proposed changes will go through the required amendment procedures as mentioned above for ordinances.

The Township Nuisance Ordinances are also being reviewed for update. The nuisance ordinances address abandoned or junk vehicles, dangerous structures, dumping, and public nuisance for disturbance of peace or safety.

The Planning Commission Meetings are held in the Township Office on the third Monday of each month with a Workshop at 6:00 PM and the regular meeting at 7:00 PM. Come on in! They are open to the public.




