Minutes of June 15, 2026

The Penn Township Board of Supervisors (PTS) met on Monday, June 15, 2026, at 4:30p.m. in the Municipal Building for a special meeting to consider the purchase of a Backhoe. Chairman Karen Potteiger, Vice-Chairman Forrest Woodward, and Supervisor John Keller attended. Other personnel present were Darrell Dethlefs (hereinafter referred to as Solicitor), Secretary Jennifer Blouch (hereinafter referred to as Secretary), and Justin Hayman (Operations Coordinator). A list of visitors attending is on file in the Township Office. Chairman Karen Potteiger convened the pledge of allegiance meeting with a moment of silence.

Public Comment:

Henry Holman III explained that in 2020 the township got rid of the John Deere and replaced it with the JCB, and he would like to know what will happen with the thumb that was purchased for the JCB this year.

Backhoe Purchase: The Operation Coordinator explained that over the last two months the JCB has been in the shop for repairs approximately 6 times, without it being fully repaired. The representative from the manufacturer can't figure out what's wrong with it. Four quotes were presented. Upon a Keller/Woodward motion, the Penn Township Supervisors voted unanimously to approve the equipment purchase of the new 2024 Case backhoe from Case Equipment under a costars contract, for \$143,000, less \$44,000 trade-in, for a total cost of \$99,000, to be paid out of general fund.

Adjournment: Upon a Keller/Woodward motion, the Penn Township Supervisors voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 4:46pm.
